



Awards Celebration



We would like to recognize our students for their accomplishments and achievements in school! Below you will find a list of awards along with the criteria required for a student to earn that award. These awards will be given following the distribution of report cards each marking period. Attendance is critical for student success in school. Lateness and early dismissal are part of our attendance policy. Students who earned weekly Royal Blue Awards and/or Virtues Awards will be recognized at the ceremony, as well. Our Awards Celebration for Marking Period 1 will be held on Thursday, November 29th at 8:45 for intermediate grades (3-5) & 9:40 for primary grades (K-2). PK students will receive their awards in the classroom this quarter.

Perfect Attendance: To earn this award, the student must not have any absences, tardies, or early dismissals. This award is applicable for students in grades Pre-K-5.

Outstanding Attendance: To earn this award, the student must not have more than 2 absences and must not have 2 tardies or early dismissals combined. This award is applicable for students in grades Pre-K-5.

High Honor Roll: To earn this award, the student must have all As on his/her report card. This award is only applicable for students in grades 4-5.

Honor Roll: To earn this award, the student must have all As and Bs on his/her report card. This award is only applicable for students in grades 4-5.

Champion of Conduct: To earn this award, the student must have all 3s in the areas of Skills and Conduct on his/her report card. This award is applicable for students in grades PK-5.

Special Area Star: To earn this award, the student must display exemplary skill, conduct, or effort in one of the special area classes. This award is only applicable for students in grades K-5.

Paw Pride: This award will be given to two students in each class, Pre-K-5, per marking period. The teacher and guidance counselor will choose the students based on our Paw Pride criteria.

Most Improved in Reading and Math: This award will be given starting during Marking Period 2. This award will be given to students who have made significant improvement in the area of reading and to students who have made significant improvement in the area of math. This award is applicable for students in grades K-5.
