COURSE DESCRIPTIONS:

Paint Party

Champion: Ms. Buttrum

Brief Description: If you enjoy painting, this is the class for you. Come join Mrs. B to learn about different styles of painting and create a new master piece each day! Grades (as of 2018-2019 school year): 4-6

Messy Mania

Champion: Ms. Orlins

Brief Description: We will be getting messy! Each day, students will indulge in sensory exploration by creating different substances, including play dough, slime, and oobleck. We will be discussing the scientific properties of these substances and carefully following recipes to make them. Students will also learn about color mixing, and we will be reading books related to science and art. Students will be able to take home some of what we make. I hope you will join me on this messy adventure!

Grades (as of 2018-2019 school year): K-3

Escape the Classroom

Brief Description: Come solve various brain teasers and puzzles in order to escape the classroom! Students will be given a series of puzzles that test their knowledge in math, science, social studies, reading, and out of the box thinking. Each puzzle will give them a different clue. Through a scientific journey, you will practice using different tools, participating in fun activities, and learning extraordinary ways to make art. Grades (as of 2018-2019 school year): 1-3

Masters of Making

Champion: Mrs. McGarvey

Brief Description: Students will utilize our Maker Space Area to create various projects. Some of these projects may be to solve problems or challenges they run into on a day to day basis. Others may be challenges set as a competition against other teams in the group. No matter the challenge, students will be encouraged to use recyclable materials, out of the box thinking, and creativity to create new inventions or improve on existing ones. Any recyclable materials that the students have at home, they are also encouraged to bring in so that we have more to work with! Grades (as of 2018-2019 school year): 5-6
