- Additional information will be sent home regarding Valentine's Day and the 100th day of school.



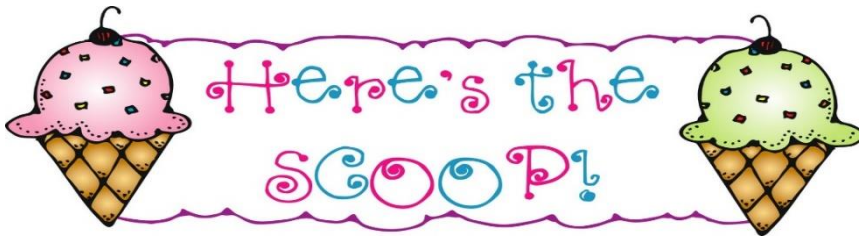
