- *Mrs. Clites' class takes the Math assessment on 2/5 and Reading on 2/7.



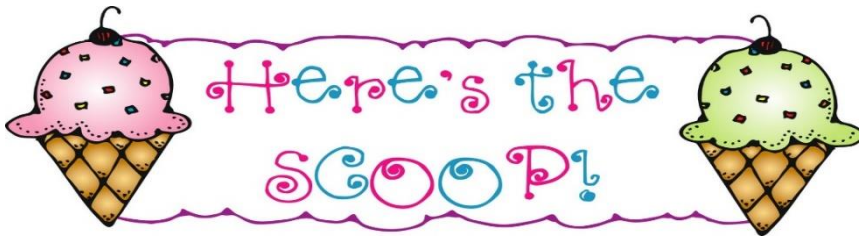
