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What are we learning?

READING: Now that we have completed beginning of the year assessments we will begin meeting in small guided groups. For phonics instruction students will soon be regrouping. In ELA the essential question of unit one is "What makes a great story?" The focus will be on describing characters, setting and events using key details from the text, both orally and in writing. We will also look at the lessons learned within a story. Students will be expected to retell a story using complete sentences.

MATH: We are continuing to explore how numbers are represented. For example students are finding addition combinations up to 10, and learning to make sense of and solve story problems. We will begin our next unit in geometry towards the end of the month.

Social Studies: In the unit "Geography Basics" students will be learning about map elements, landforms, man-made features and relative locations.
