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What are we learning?

READING: Over the next few weeks in ELA phonics, we will be doing the Smart Start Unit reviewing skills that were learned in Kindergarten.

MATH: The essential question of unit one is "How are numbers represented?" Students will be able to accurately use various symbols in math (+, -, =, >, <). We will also represent numbers in many ways, as well as explaining our thinking, when solving word problems.

Conscious Discipline: This is new to first grade however students were introduced to it last year. The focus is on teaching students skills to support social emotional learning and self-regulation strategies.
