What are we learning this month?

English/Language Arts:

Students will start to study the concepts of journeys. They will be writing a personal narrative about a personal journey. In Word Work, students will be starting the study of long and short vowel sounds in multisyllabic words.

Health:

Students will be learning about personal health. Topics will include mental and emotional health. Students will apply it to their own life. They will create a brochure or pamphlet highlighting total personal wellness with examples of how to apply strategies in everyday life.

Mathematics:

Our first unit is place value/adding and subtracting. In this unit, students use place value concepts to estimate and compare numbers. Students use properties of operations and number sense to perform multi-digit arithmetic.
