What are we learning this month?

ELA:

In Unit 6, students will analyze the narrative elements of character, setting, point of view and theme through the lens of literature circle discussions during an extended novel study. With the opportunity to rotate roles, students will facilitate their own collaborative conversations during literature circles where an emphasis on active listening and participation will allow for practice of the speaking and listening standards.

Math:

In Unit 6, students will use rules to create and extend a number pattern and identify features of the number pattern not described by the rule. They identify and classify types of lines, angles, and polygons. Students identify lines of symmetry in two-dimensional shapes. They calculate the area and perimeter of two-dimensional shapes. Students measure angles accurately using benchmark fractions and protractors.

Health:

In the "Nutrition and Fitness" unit, students will learn about various topics related to fitness and nutrition including specific nutrients, dietary guidelines, and how to read food labels.
