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What are we learning?

READING: In our next unit titled "Amazing World", students will be learning the elements of non-fiction and the text features "good readers" use to gain information. The focus of this unit will be learning about various animals and the world they live in.

MATH: We are finishing up Geometry and getting ready to start Unit 3: Addition, Subtraction and the Number System 2. This unit focuses on counting to higher numbers (forward and back), counting sets of objects, comparing, composing and decomposing numbers, and finding two-addend combinations. **Science:** We are starting the unit "Creepers and Creature Features". Students are being asked to design a solution to a human problem that mimics the way a plant or animal survives, grows and meets its needs.
