### A Look at Our Curriculum

#### \*ELA-

We will finish the year with a unit about poetry. As students read a variety of poems, they will gain a deeper appreciation for different types of poetry, such as free verse, descriptive verse, limericks, and nonsense narratives.

#### \*Math-

We will finish out the year with math challenges that utilize the problem solving skills that we have learned this year. Concepts such as multiplication, division, reasoning, fractions, etc will be used in real life scenarios.

#### \*Health-

Our last unit of study covers the effects of drugs on the body, including how drugs can be helpful (medicine) and harmful (tobacco, caffeine). Students learn strategies for refusing drugs. The unit also covers safe responses to emergency and non-emergency situations, as well as strategies to prevent or treat communicable diseases and parasites.
