What are we learning this month?

English Language Arts

In Unit 4, students examine a variety of literary text including tall tales, poetry and novels. They continue to summarize and determine the theme of these texts while being introduced to the concept of tone. They explore authors craft in order to determine how authors' create high quality pieces of writing.

Mathematics

Students will apply the Order of Operations when evaluating writing, and interpreting expressions. In addition, students classify triangles and quadrilaterals and develop a hierarchy of quadrilaterals based on their properties.
