What are we learning this month?

English/Language Arts:

Students continue to study the concept of journeys. They will be writing a personal narrative about a personal journey. In Word Work, students will continue the study of long and short vowel sounds in multisyllabic words.

Geography and Economics of the United States: Students will research the state of Maryland to determine how its physical and human characteristics impact the lives of its citizens.

Mathematics:

Students continue to work on place value/adding and subtracting. In this unit, students use place value concepts to estimate and compare numbers. Students use properties of operations and number sense to perform multi-digit arithmetic.
