A Look at Our Curriculum

*ELA- We will be working on our first unit of study titled, "A Delicate Balance". This unit will include non-fiction texts that focus on endangered animals. The students will be completing in-class research projects about a specific endangered animal.

*Math- Our first unit of study is titled, "Understanding Multiplication and Division". Students will represent and solve problems involving multiplication and division, apply properties of multiplication, and understand the relationship between multiplication and division. We will be using hands-on activities to strengthen your student's skills in this concept. Your child will be coming home with a bag of vocabulary words for this unit. Please encourage your student to practice using these words when they talk about math.

*Health - Our first unit is a mini-unit that focuses on building relationships with others and yourself.

*Science - Mayfly Mayhem is our first unit of study. In this unit, students will be able to prove with evidence why organisms form groups to survive, the characteristics of healthy habitats, and how these organisms learn to adapt to various changes in their environment over time.

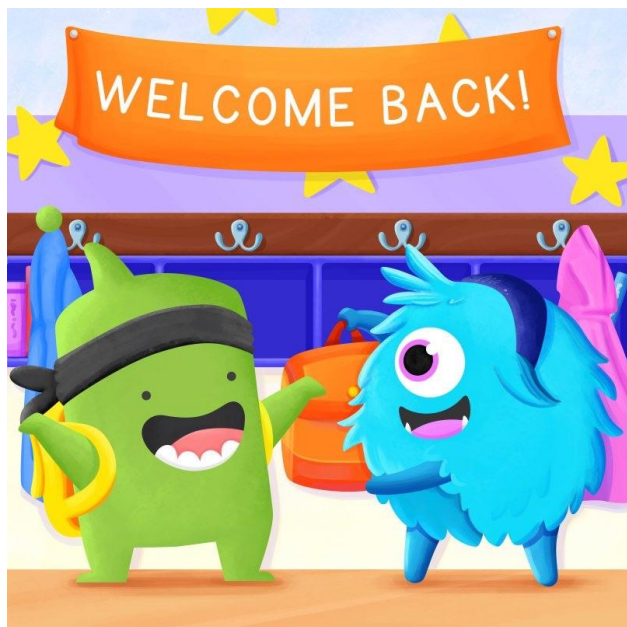




Star Students
